Hall of Fame Exhibit Dedication

The opening and dedication of the Richard M. Fairbanks, Indiana Broadcast Pioneers, Hall of Fame exhibit will take place on June 1, 2006 at the Indiana State Museum.

Pioneer President Paul Lennon, in his second term, has worked long and hard to make this event possible. Thanks to his efforts and the invaluable participation of the Richard M. Fairbanks Foundation and the Indiana State Museum, there now exists a permanent display, recognizing Indiana broadcasters who have distinguished themselves with dignity and prestige in the industry.
